



Voter Registration Information

Pursuant to the Higher Education Act of 1965 and the National Voter Registration Act of 1993, the below voter information is provided for you. Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia recognizes the need for responsible citizenship and encourages MTSA students to participate in federal, state and local elections.

For Tennessee residents –

You must be a U.S. citizen, Tennessee resident and at least 18 years old on or before Election Day to be eligible to vote in addition to other requirements. Voter registration is handled at the county level. An application for voter registration must be postmarked or hand delivered to the proper county election commission office at least 30 days before an election.
