Payment Information

Students making self-payments for tuition charges must ensure payments are received by the deadlines listed to avoid late fees. (Late fees = \$100/Business Day.)

A \$30 fee will be assessed for each occurrence of a check returned by a bank for insufficient funds, account closed or any other reason.

If using a credit card, a 3% fee will be assessed to process.

Third-Party payments – Students receiving benefits paid directly to MTSA must notify the Business Office with documentation from the third-party payer prior to the published payment due date. Students are responsible for any difference between the account charges and the third-party payment. *Regardless of an existing agreement between a Student and Third-Party payer, students are ultimately responsible for ensuring that MTSA receives payment for their tuition.*

Reminders

- If you are requesting financial assistance, make sure your aid is correctly reflected in your student portal and accepted by **November 10, 2024**. Any adjustments to your aid package will need to be emailed to finaid@mtsa.edu. Please remember that all loan awards must be repaid to the loan holder.
- If considering private loan options, you may visit www.elmselect.com to research a lender option. In "School Search" field, enter "Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia" – scroll down and click "View Loans" to review the list of lenders frequently used by MTSA students. Contact your chosen to complete the application and expect to fill out the lender's **Private Loan Self-Certification form**. Email your lender's name and amount you are borrowing to finaid@mtsa.edu. (MTSA does not have a preferred lender list or arrangement)
- If your mailing address changes at any time during your program, you must notify the Registrar, registrar@mtsa.edu, with your new address. This will ensure you receive your 1098-T year end statements.
- Submit the 25-26 FAFSA by **June 30, 2025**.

 - (3) Private education loan (contact the private lender of your choice and complete all necessary paperwork)
- B. Accept your financial aid on your student portal by **November 10, 2024**. Email any adjustments to your financial aid package to finaid@mtsa.edu.
- C. Report any outside scholarship or tuition assistance you will be receiving to finaid@mtsa.edu.

Disbursement Information

Your tuition will be deducted from the financial aid disbursement each semester and any excess financial aid will be deposited into your bank account via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). You will complete an EFT Authorization form on your student portal if you are a first-time borrower at MTSA. If you change banks or bank account numbers during your program, contact Nathan Johnson, to complete a new EFT Authorization.

Loan Cancellation Procedure

You may cancel any part of the federal loan disbursement you were offered before the loan disbursement date. Once MTSA receives the loan funds, you have the right to cancel all or part of your loan funds within 14 days after the disbursement date(s) for the loan period. To cancel any or all of loan funds received, confirm in writing the loan(s) and amount(s) you wish to cancel and send the request to finaid@mtsa.edu. If the reduction or cancellation of loan funds results in a balance on your account, you will be responsible for paying the remaining balance.
